

The Réseau québécois sur l'énergie intelligente (RQEI) is composed of a diverse group of researchers, postdoctoral fellows, graduate students and research staff from universities and colleges. Located throughout Québec, these institutions have their own technical teams and research infrastructure. One of RQEI's objectives is to facilitate collaboration between its research teams, share infrastructure and promote their achievements in Québec, Canada and internationally.

The program aims to provide funding to be used as a strategic lever to support the creation of research chairs, programs requiring complementary funding or promising projects in terms of new collaborations between regular RQEI research members. It is designed to encourage the emergence of collaborative and cross-sector projects in each of RQEI's research areas, while contributing to the advancement of scientific knowledge. This type of funding can also be used to prepare the first phase of a project. Inter-institutional and inter-level projects are encouraged.

Particular attention will be paid to the processing of applications to promote equity in the allocation of funds among research teams and across the three RQEI research areas. Applications must involve at least two RQEI co-researcher members. New collaborations between members will be encouraged. Funding awarded under a previous competition does not guarantee subsequent funding; any new application must present distinct objectives, a new phase or a clearly demonstrated added value.

Funding objectives:

1. Support collaboration among RQEI members.
2. Promote the development and exchange of expertise within RQEI.
3. Help develop relationships among RQEI member institutions.
4. Contribute to the training of RQEI member teams.
5. Promote the research work of RQEI members in Canada and internationally.

Requirements:

1. Applications must involve at least two RQEI co-researcher members.
2. The project must be in line with RQEI's scientific program (<https://www.rqei.ca/recherche/>).
3. The project must meet at least two funding objectives.
4. Only one application will be considered per beneficiary/principal applicant for the duration of the program.

Funding:

1. Up to \$45,000 per project, of which at least 50% must be dedicated to financial support for graduate students and/or bursaries/salaries for postdoctoral fellows working on the project. Total 2026-2027 envelope: \$135,000, subject to availability and until the envelope is exhausted.

Evaluation procedure:

1. Suitability of the project for RQEI research programming.
2. Relevance of the project to the pooling of RQEI members' expertise and infrastructure.
3. Relevance of activities to the development of new professional collaborations within RQEI.
4. Leverage potential for a subsequent funding application and expected outcomes, without constituting automatic continuation funding.
5. Evaluation by experts from an external evaluation bank, with declaration and management of conflicts of interest.

Planning:

1. Program launch: 6 September 2026.
2. Application deadline: 13 November 2026.
3. Announcement of results: December 2026.
4. Receipt of funding: announcement of results + 2 to 6 weeks.
5. End of project: January 2028 (reporting and results).

Application procedure:

Applicants must submit the completed form and any document that can support the application (team presentation, previous work, current or future complementary funding, timeline, budget, figures or appendices) in a single PDF document. Documents must be sent by e-mail to rqei@uqtr.ca. The e-mail subject line should read: "RQEI2026-PROG_AMORCAGE" followed by a space and your last name in upper case.
